MAIN MOTION

1	A MAIN MOTION
2	To amend Article IV, Section 3 of the bylaws, effectively expanding complementary membership in the
3	Association to any newly commissioned officer or appointed warrant officer in the Louisiana
4	National Guard for a period of up to two years.
5	WHEREAS, the National Guard Association of Louisiana (NGALA) currently offers a
6	complimentary membership to newly commissioned Second Lieutenants and Warrant Officers appointed in
7	the Louisiana National Guard between the previous year's annual conference and the current years' annual
8	conference; and,
9	WHEREAS, the complimentary membership is valid for the balance of the calendar year in which
10	they are appointed and the next full year's membership for the succeeding calendar year; and,
11	WHEREAS, this complimentary membership is not provided to new officer and warrant officer
12	members of the Louisiana National Guard that are not newly commissioned; and,
13	WHEREAS, the National Guard Association of the United States (NGAUS) currently offers a free
14	one-time complimentary annual membership for newly commissioned or newly assessed National Guard
15	officers and warrant officers; and,
16	WHEREAS, this complimentary membership is available to newly appointed officers and warrant
17	officers regardless of grade for calendar year in which it is purchased through the following calendar year;
18	and,
19	WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Association to closely align its membership options with NGAUS
20	to benefit the member.
21	THEREFORE, A MAIN MOTION is hereby made, in writing, and submitted effective 14 January
22	2025, to amend Article IV, Section 3 of the bylaws to read as follows:

MAIN MOTION ORIGINAL

1 Complimentary Membership. Newly commissioned officers and newly appointed warrant

- 2 officers in the Louisiana National Guard, regardless of grade, will be given a complimentary membership.
- 3 The complimentary membership is effective from the date of their commission or appointment through the
- 4 end of the following calendar year. New officers and warrant officers to the Louisiana National Guard that
- 5 are not otherwise eligible will not be afforded the benefits of a complimentary membership.
